Who We Are

Cure 4 The Kids Foundation (C4K) is Nevada's only nonprofit, pediatric treatment center for cancer and other rare diseases.

Mission – To advance cures and treatment of childhood cancer and other rare diseases

Projected clinic numbers for 2025:

- 8,000 unique patients
- 26,000 patient visits
- 200 C4K employees

Specialty Care Provided By:

- 6 Board-certified Pediatric Hematology/Oncology, MD
 - 6 Pediatric Hem/Onc Nurse Practitioners, DNP or APRN
- Board-certified Pediatric Orthopedic Surgeon, MD
 - Pediatric Orthopedics, PA-C
- Physical Therapist, DPT
- Board-certified Clinical Neuropsychologist, PhD
- Board-certified in Pediatric Genetics, MD
 - Certified Genetic Counselor, MA, CGC
- Board-certified in Pediatric Rheumatology, MD



Our Learning Center

- Opened in 2020 with seed funding from the Andre Agassi Foundation for Education
- Through a direct partnership with CCSD, we have a dedicated **Educational Facilitator** on-site and a part-time **Guidance Counselor**
 - Giving direct communication with student's teachers and principals, streamlining plans, assignments, and re-entry
- **Goal:** prevent students from falling through the cracks or disengaging from school after diagnosis.
 - In 2025, we had a graduating class of 40 seniors
 - Currently supporting 165 active students with our services
- We assist families with:
 - **504 Plans** – classroom accommodations and supports so a student can access learning without changing the curriculum
 - **IEPs (Individualized Education Programs)** – specialized instruction and services
- **Janie's Classroom** honors Janie, a beloved CCSD teacher, angel cancer warrior, and daughter of a C4K advocate who helped our founder secure the district partnership to meet our patients' educational needs.

Our Book Vending Machine

- We've installed a **book vending machine** in the lobby filled with only brand-new books for patients of all ages as an extension of our Learning Center.
 - Emphasis on new, never used books is for the health of our immunocompromised patients.
- Patients receive tokens from doctors and nurses as a form of **positive reinforcement**—for bravery, medical milestones, or just showing up.
- We distribute **over 2,500 new books every year** through this program.




Why Books Matter

What Our Patients Miss:


- School routines, book fairs, field trips, and everyday childhood experiences.
